

Job Description – Construction Concrete Finisher

Classification – Non-exempt

Salary Grade/Level/Family/Range - \$18 - \$22 per hour

Reports to – Crew Foreman

Summary/Objective

The concrete finisher performs tasks involving physical labor on heavy construction projects. The position may operate a variety of hand and power tools and may clean and prepare sites, dig trenches, set braces, clean up rubble and debris, and remove waste materials. The position may assist other craft workers.

Responsibilities

1. Operates a screed to level freshly placed concrete according to grade and depth specification
2. Smooth concrete surface using either a hand trowel, long handled “bull float” powered float and/or riding trowel machines
3. Cut joints/grooves in concrete with edging tools to help control cracking, as well as layout and sawcut joints with an early entry saw
4. Apply hardening and sealing components to cure surfaces
5. Monitor the wind, heat and cold as it affects the curing of concrete
6. Set and place forms to proper elevations and location, prepare the base and install proper reinforcing
7. Install anchor bolts, steel plates and other fixtures into freshly poured concrete and/or pattern or stamp the surface to provide a decorative finish

Abilities Required

1. Profound knowledge of surface designs
2. Familiarity with curb and gutter work and flatwork
3. Proficient with the use of hand and power tools
4. Ability to work under pressure
5. Ability to handle multi tasks

Supervisory Responsibility

This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

Work Environment

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently exposed to fumes or airborne particles, moving mechanical parts and vibration. The employee is occasionally exposed to a variety of extreme conditions at construction job sites. The noise level in the work environment and job sites can be loud. The position regularly works near moving mechanical parts and in outside conditions that include inclement weather, heat and humidity, and exposure to dust and asphalt.

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Physical Demands

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.

The position lifts heavy objects, walks and stands for long periods of time and performs strenuous physical labor under adverse field conditions. The employee lifts, pushes, pulls or carries objects; uses abdominal and lower back muscles to provide support over time without fatigue; and effectively jumps, sprints or throws objects. The position requires good manual dexterity (hand, hand with arm, two hands) and multi-limb coordination. The position requires the ability to quickly move arms and legs. The employee must have excellent stamina.

Position Type/Expected Hours of Work

This is a full-time position. Core Days and hours of work are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., 40 hours per week. This position frequently requires overtime hours and weekend work.

Required Education and Experience

Must have at least 2 years' experience as a concrete finisher

1. Must possess or be able to obtain a valid and appropriate state driver's license prior to employment.
